- Tied with Maggie Ewen as the women's individual high scorer at the NCAA Division I Outdoor Championships with 20 points (1st long jump, 1st triple jump).
 - Became just third woman in NCAA Division I history to claim national outdoor titles in long jump and triple jump in same season.
- Broke her own indoor triple jump American and **COLLEGIATE RECORD** with a mark of 14.53m (47-8) at the Clemson Invitational on January 20
 - Previous record set by Orji on February 25, 2017, at 14.32m (46-11¾)
 - Along with the indoor collegiate record in triple jump, she posted five of the top 10 best jumps in collegiate history this season.
- Broke her own outdoor triple jump **COLLEGIATE RECORD** with a mark of 14.62m (47-11¾) at the SEC Outdoor Championships on May 13
 - Previous record set by Orji on June 11, 2016, at 14.53m (47-8)
 - Outdoors, she added three of the best six jumps in collegiate history.
