HIGHLIGHTS

- NCAA indoor championship (March 9) in the 60 meters, won in 6.50: Ranks No. 10 in collegiate history, making Holloway the No. 8-best performer on the list, Ranks No. 2 in the world in 2019
- NCAA indoor championship (March 9) in the 60 meter hurdles, won in 7.35: Set an AMERICAN RECORD. Set a COLLEGIATE RECORD. Set a championships record, Ranks No. 3 in world history and is the world-leading performance of 2019.
- Scored second-most individual points (27½) in NCAA indoor championships history (1st 60, 1st 60H, 3rd LJ, 3rd 4x400). Is only the third to sweep 60 meters and 60 meter hurdles in the same NCAA indoor championships.
- Scored 28 individual points at SEC indoor championships, an all-time best.
- NCAA outdoor championship (June 7) in the 110 meter hurdles, won in 12.98: Set a COLLEGIATE RECORD. Set a championships record, Placed him No. 18 in world history on the all-time performers list and is the world-leading performance of 2019. Only the third man to break 13.00 since the start of 2016 (Omar McLeod, Sergey Shubenkov)
- NCAA outdoor championship (June 7) in the 4x100 relay as the second leg, won in 37.97: Set a COLLEGIATE RECORD. Set a championships record
- Recorded four of the eight fastest races in collegiate history in the 110 meter hurdles (12.98, 13.07, 13.10, 13.12).
- Recorded four of the top six fastest races in collegiate history in the 60 meter hurdles (7.35, 7.43, 7.44 twice).
