#### WIN-LOSS RECORD

- 12-3 in event finals versus collegians
- 2-2 in long jump indoors
- 4-0 in long jump outdoors
- 3-0 in triple jump indoors
- 3-1 in triple jump outdoors

#### HIGHLIGHTS

- NCAA outdoor championship (June 6) in the long jump, won with a best mark of 6.84m (22-5¼): Ranks No. 4 in the world in 2019, Recorded the third-best mark in championship history, Equaled the seventh best performer in collegiate history with the 10th best mark
- SEC outdoor championship (May 11) in the triple jump, won with a best mark of 14.35m (47-1): Ranks No. 9 in the world in 2019, Ranks her as the second best performer with the third best mark in collegiate history
- Second woman in history to sweep the horizontal jumps titles at both SEC Indoor and Outdoor Championships in the same year. Her collective 34 points at both NCAA championships in 2019 led the nation.
- Only woman in collegiate history currently in the all-time top-ten in both horizontal jumps
- Posted four wind-legal triple jumps of 14-plus meters, a distance no other collegian reached this year
- Won NCAA Indoor Championships triple jump title by 20 centimeters
