

# Butler County Community J.C. Wins NJCAA Cross Country Crown

*Reginald McAfee of Brevard College Gains Individual Title*

Butler County Community Junior College of Eldorado, Kansas, ran off with top honors in the NJCAA Cross Country Championships at Vincennes, Indiana.

Allegheny Community College of Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, was second while defending champion, host Vincennes University, took third place honors on a cold rain-soaked course of 4.179 miles over the Vincennes Elks Club golf course.

Individual honors went to Reginald McAfee of Brevard College, Brevard, North Carolina, with a time of 20:30.8. Galen Hackler and Vinny DeRosa of Manatee Junior College were second and third.

The temperature at the time of the two trip loop over the rolling hills just east of Vincennes was a chilly 39 degrees. More than 250 runners started the race to mark the largest field to ever compete in the NJCAA Championship, and 247 competitors completed the circuit.
