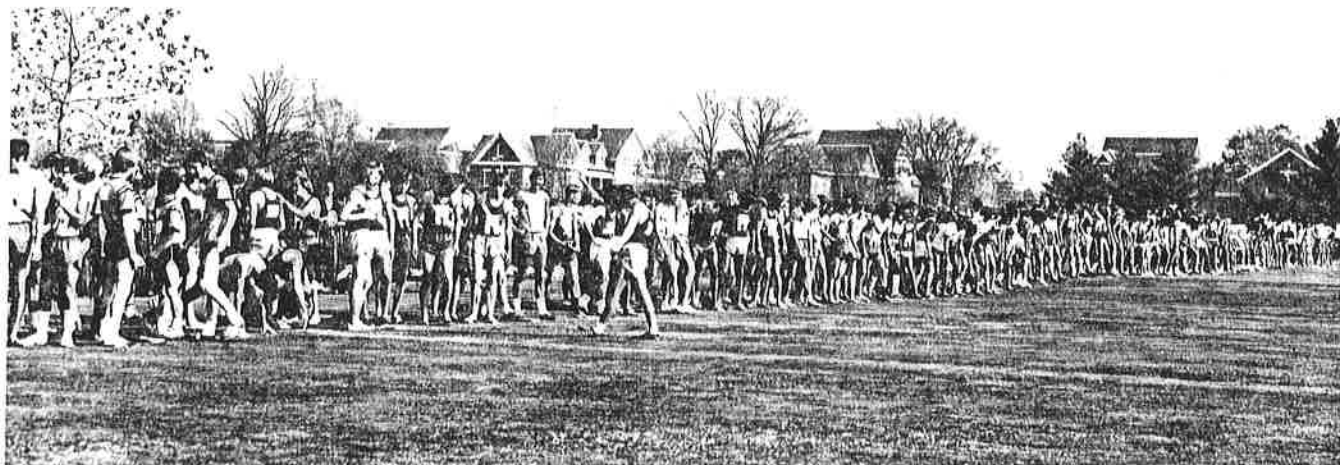


# Vincennes University J.C. Wins NJCAA Cross Country Championship

*Herb Gibson of C.C. of Allegheny, South Campus Gains Individual Title*

Vincennes University Junior College of Vincennes, Indiana, won the 1971 NJCAA Cross Country Championship at Danville, Illinois.

Community College of Allegheny County, Allegheny Campus, was second, while the defending champions, Butler County Community Junior College of El Dorado, Kansas was third over the 4.0 mile course.

Individual honors went to Herb Gibson of Community College of Allegheny County, Allegheny Campus, with a time of 19:40.4. Sam Torres of Genesee Community College, Flint, Michigan, was second followed by Hollie Walton of Johnson and Wales J.C., Providence, Rhode Island, in third place. 263 runners started the race to mark the largest field to ever compete in the NJCAA Championship.
