

Lane Community College Wins Cross Country Title

Fred Carnahan of Platte College Gains Individual Crown

Fred Carnahan of Platte Junior College, Columbus, Nebraska, captured the NJCAA Cross Country Championship race at Ellyson Field in Pensacola, Florida in the winning time of 20:06.

Gordy Benfield of Golden Valley Lutheran JC, Golden Valley, Minn., took second with 20:15 and Alex Smith of Kingsborough Community College, Brooklyn, N.Y. finished third with a time of 20:36.

Team honors went to Lane Community College of Eugene, Oregon with 85 points. Runner-up was Glendale CC of Glendale, Ariz., with 98 followed by Penn State University, Berks Campus, with 143 points. Fourth and fifth place team honors were taken by Allegheny College of Pittsburgh, 166 points, and Butler County JC of El Dorado, Kansas, 191 tallies.

Rain, which had preceded the race, probably slowed the time somewhat. The weather for the race was clear with the temperature in the low seventies, the kind of balmy day that visitors and Floridians alike really enjoy.

The race was hosted by Pensacola Junior College but run at the Navy's Ellyson Field because of superior facilities.
